# Spring Course Registration and Cold Weather - Fast Approaching!

Spring 2025 course registration has begun! Meet with your academic advisor, faculty mentor, or program coordinator to discuss your eligibility for registration. You should also check your email for communication about registration.

Register for classes as soon as possible in order to have the schedule you want - classes fill up quickly!

Registration dates:

- Graduate students: 7 a.m. -Nov. 4th
- Seniors (90+ earned credit hours): 7 a.m. Nov. 5th
- Juniors (60-89 earned credit hours): 7 a.m. Nov. 12th
- Sophomore (30-59 earned credit hours): 7 a.m. - Nov. 19th
- Freshmen (0-29 earned credit hours): 7 a.m. - Dec.
   3rd

\*Check your earned credit hours in Banner.

If you have a hold on your account, you will be unable to register for classes. Common holds include: registration advisor meeting, student

health immunizations, student accounts third-party billing. To release a hold from your account, you should contact the designated office listed here: LINK

#### **Cold Weather**

Registration isn't the only thing starting in November - cold weather has begun! In St. Louis, temperatures in the Winter average 29°F or -2°C. It is necessary to purchase and wear appropriate cold-weather gear. Some Winter weather items you will need are: hat, scarf, gloves, coat, long pants, long-sleeve shirts, warm socks, closed-toe shoes. If you drive a vehicle, be aware that the roads become slick with ice - drive slow and carefully! Although cold weather can be dangerous, it can also be fun! Sledding, ice skating, and building a snowman are all Winter activities you can do in Forest Park!

## Winter Break Travel Signatures and Scams - IMPORTANT!

#### **Travel Signatures:**

Travel signatures for Winter break travel: Dec. 14th - Jan. 12th.

You should submit a travel signature request in the student portal if you have plans to travel outside of the US.

\*If you leave early, you CANNOT complete coursework for in-person classes, online.

Returning to the US late (after January 12th) is strongly discouraged - you may be denied entry to the US if you choose to attempt this.

These are United States regulations on student visas.


